It is the biggest beach on Chichijima Island. The beautiful white sand and calm waters are inviting.



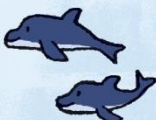
Anijima

The natural beauty of the Ogasawara Islands is fragile. So many places have rules to protect it. They also limit visitors. Go with a guide and make the most of your visit.

Heart Rock

Chihiroiwa, a 200-meter high cliff, rises from the sea in the south of Chichijima. From the sea, the red rock appears heart-shaped. This gives the cliff its nickname, "Heart Rock". With a guide, you can climb it and enjoy a wide view of the Pacific Ocean.



Sea Turtles



The Ogasawara Islands are home to the endangered turtles. The turtles spend their lives at sea. But on early summer nights, they return to lay eggs. Two months later, again at night, the baby turtles are born and crawl to the ocean. The fragile cycle starts again. Come with a guide to watch the turtles. You will never forget it.
